### Reminders for In-Person Clinic Visits

#### Before your visit...

• The medical team from EHHOP will call you on Friday to ask you a few questions to screen for potential symptoms of COVID. This is in order to ensure your safety, and the safety of other patients and clinicians.

#### On the day of your visit...

- On Saturday, please arrive 15 minutes before your appointment.
- We are trying to reduce the number of people in the waiting room. If necessary, you can bring up to one person to come with you.
- Wear a mask if you can. If you don't have one, they will be provided.
- When you enter the EHHOP clinic, a doctor on the 7th floor will ask you the same questions you were asked on Friday to screen for potential symptoms of COVID.

# **Emergency Medicaid Extension**

We want to remind you that due to the pandemic, all Emergency Medicaid insurance that was supposed to expire between March 31, 2020 and July 31, 2020 will be automatically extended to expire on the original expiration month and day, but in 2021. The Access to Care (ACT) team at EHHOP is aware of these changes, and is helping patients as needed.

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
## Mask Availability

Moving forward, reusable cloth face masks will be available in clinic. If you need a new reusable face mask, please let us know and you can pick up your mask at EHHOP (17 E. 102 Street, 7th floor) during limited clinic hours (every Saturday, 9am - 12pm). ### Insulin Pen Handouts

All insulin pens and insulin refills will come with a handout with pictures showing each step involved in using an insulin pen. We hope that it will be a helpful guide for using your insulin pen, and that it can help to remind you of each step involved in taking your insulin. You can expect to receive this sheet with your insulin pen and refills, as well as a follow up phone call from a member of our EHHOP team to see if you found this handout helpful.
